Finance

The end of year accounts at 31 March 2015 showed receipts of £18,029.04 and payments of £15,737.13. The bank balance at the end of year stood at £22,373.64 which included earmarked reserves of £7,700.00. A precept of £14,454 was set for 2015/16 which was reduced to £13,127 as it was agreed to accept a grant of £1,327 from NNDC.
