The Memorial bench seat continues to be well used and I am really pleased with the new bed on the bank behind it. We continue with our battle with the moles that are all around. Our thanks again go to Jane and her team for the wonderful work they are doing with the plants around the village, the First Responders for the maintenance of the Defibrillator and of course to our bus shelter cleaners. Again, thanks to the weather, our grit bins have not really been tested, but it is good to have them in place. I would also like to thank County Highways for their prompt responses to our monthly reports of Potholes. It is also good to see that we have finally got the Norwich Road re-surfaced and look forward to the bridge section being completed in the near future. ## Finance

The end of year accounts at 31 March 2016 showed receipts of £32,153.31 and payments of £14,235.89. The bank balance at the end of year stood at £40,291.06 which included earmarked reserves of £24,143.00. A precept of £14,454 was set for 2016/17 which was reduced to £13,300 as it was agreed to accept a grant of £1,154 from NNDC.
