## Finance

The end of year accounts at 31 March 2017 showed receipts of £19,720.30 and payments of £31,711.94. The bank balance at the end of year stood at £28,299.42 which included earmarked reserves of £11,700.00. A precept of £15,629 was set for 2017/18 which was reduced to £14,602 as it was agreed to accept a grant of £1,027 from NNDC. This equates to approximately £38 per annum per band D household.
