## Chairman's Report for 2018/19

## Finance

The end of year accounts at 31 March 2019 showed receipts of £18,766.91 and payments of £16,096.35. The bank balance at the end of year stood at £31,132.61 which included earmarked reserves of £15,300. A precept of £15,945 was set for 2019/20 which was reduced to £15,076 as it was agreed to accept a grant of £869 from NNDC. This equates to approximately £38.64 per annum per band D household.
